It is based on 24 of the songs found in the medieval collection Carmina Burana. Its full Latin title is Carmina Burana: Cantiones profanae cantoribus et choris cantandae comitantibus instrumentis atque imaginibus magicis (Songs by Beuern: Secular songs for singers and choirs to be singed along with musical instruments and magic pictures.) Carmina Burana is part of Trionfi, the musical triptych that also includes the Catoli Cantata Carmina and Trionfo. The best-known movement is the Fortuna Imperix Mundi (O Fortuna), which opens and closes the work. Orff first came across text in an 1884 wine, women's and Song by John Eddington Simmonds, which included English translations of 46 songs from the collection. Michel Hoffmann, a young law student and Latin and Greek enthusiast, helped Aurf select and organize these 24 songs into Libretto, mostly in Latin verse, with a small amount of Middle German and ancient Provençal. The selection covers a wide range of subjects, recognized in the 13th century as they are in the 21st century: the fickleness of luck and wealth, the enduring nature of life, the joy of spring's return, and the pleasures and dangers of drinking, granolas, gambling and lust. Carmina Burana was first staged in Frankfurt by the Frankfurt Opera on June 8, 1937 (conductor: Bartel) Choir Cäcilienchor, directed by Oscar Wälterlin sets and costumes by Ludwig Sievert). Shortly after the successful premiere, Orff wrote the following letter to his opposite, Shot Music: Everything I've written so far, and that you, unfortunately, are printed, can be destroyed. With Carmina Burana, the collected works begin. Several shows were repeated elsewhere in Germany. The Nazi regime was initially nervous about the erotic tone of some of the songs, but eventually embraced the piece. It became the most famous piece of music composed in Germany during this period. The popularity of the work continued to rise after the war, and until the 1960s Karmina Burana was well established as part of the international classical repertoire. Alex Ross wrote that music itself does not commit sins just by being popular. The fact that Carmina Burana has appeared in hundreds of films and television commercials is proof that it contains no diabolical message, and indeed contains no message. The passion that Orff expressed in his letter to Mul largely came true: no other composition of his approaches would be reputational, as evidenced by both pop culture appropriation for Lao Fortuna and the constant programming and recording of the classical world of the work. In the United States, Carmina Burana represents one of the few box office mods in 20th-century music.
